The Beers...

16MILE: As Delaware's newest microbrewery, 16 Mile concentrates on creating full-bodied ales with the clean honest taste of hops and malted barley. 16 Mile salutes the rich history and heritage of Delaware. Look for familiar historical landmarks on its bottles of Amber Sun Ale, Old Court Ale, and Blues' Golden Ale.

ABITA: Founded in 1986, the Abita Brewing Company is 30 miles North of New Orleans. They brew over 109,000 barrels of beer and 6,000 barrels of root beer. They use pure, clean tasting water from Abita Springs to brew their beers.

BREWDOG: This Scottish Brewery is located in Fraserburgh, Aberdeenshire. Known for making cool, contemporary and progressive beers.

CLIPPER CITY: Opened in 1989, encouraging the re-emergence of craft beer in Baltimore. Clipper City Brewing produces over 14 styles of ales and lagers, and is distributed in over 18 states.

DOGFISH HEAD: Brewed and bottled at Dogfish Head Brewery in Milton, Delaware. Dogfish is known for funky flavors, seasonal brews, and microbrews.

ERIE BREWING CO: Was founded in October of 1993 in Erie, PA. Its original location was Union Station/Hoppers Brew Pub, and it began with a manufacturing capacity of 1040 barrels, or 2080 1/2 kegs.

FLYING DOG: Opened in 1990 in Aspen, Colorado and now located in Frederick, Maryland. Flying Dog Brewery has a number of types of beer such as The Pack, Canis Major, Seasonal, and Wild Dog.

FLYING FISH: The Largest craft breweries in New Jersey, founded in 1995 as the web's first virtual brewery. Flying Fish beers are designed to complement food, the flavors harmonize and balance with each other; equal or superior to wine.

LEINENKUGEL'S: An American beermaker opened at Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin in 1867 by Jacob Leinenkugel himself. Now you can find his beers all through the Mid-West in year-round and seasonal brews.

LONG TRAIL: A microbrewery located in Bridgewater, Vermont. Long Trail makes a number of different styles of beer from English-style top-fermented ales, a Düsseldorf-style altbier, and a "Sticke" Alt

MORETTI: In 1859, Luigi Moretti founded his "Beer and Ice Factory" in Udine, Italy, in the region of Friuli. Moretti is the authentic and most preferred Italian beer. It is now exported to more than 30 countries worldwide.

PALM: Belgium's best selling specialty beer.

PAULANER: Paulaner ranks number 8 among Germany's best selling breweries.

OMMEGANG: A Belgian brewery located in New York. Ommegang distributes its beer to 43 states and even Sweden after commercial inquiries

OTTER CREEK: Otter Creek Brewing is a microbrewery located in Middlebury, Vermont. It produces two lines of beer: Otter Creek Craft Ales and Wolaver's Certified Organic Ales.

SAPPORO: One of Japan's most famous beers. Seibe Nakagawa, a German-trained brewer, became the first brewmaster of the Kaitakushi Brewery in June 1876, and the first Sapporo Lager was produced at that time.

SHIPYARD: Based in Maine, and first began in 1992 at a Brew Pub. All beer is hand crafted from recipes developed by master brewer Alan Pugsley, one of the most influential people in the craft brewing movement in North America.

SIERRA NEVADA: Located in Chico, CA, Sierra Nevada Brewing is one of the most popular craft breweries in the United States. Its Pale Ale is world renowned, and the brewery produces almost 700,000 barrels of beer per year.

STEINLAGER: Is New Zealand's biggest export beers

TRÖEGS: Is an American brewery in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania founded in 1996. It is a craft-brewery, or microbrewery focusing their production on specialty and seasonal beers.

TWIN LAKES: Located on Twin Lakes Farm, a site with a long and prestigious history dating back to our founding fathers George Washington and Caesar Rodney. The Camp Brandywine National Landmark stands 250 yards from the property line. Twin Lakes features a four-vessel, gravity-fed brewery producing ales, pilsners and stouts.

VICTORY: Victory Brewing Company (Victory) is a brewery founded in 1996 in Downingtown, Pennsylvania, USA. The main brands are HopDevil, Prima Pils and Storm King, which are distributed in 23 states.

WOODCHUCK: All ciders start at their local cidery in Middlebury, Vermont first opened in 1990. And is carefully made through each step of the way, from the apple press to the fermentation and finally bottled and ready to send out.
